Residents: No Charge

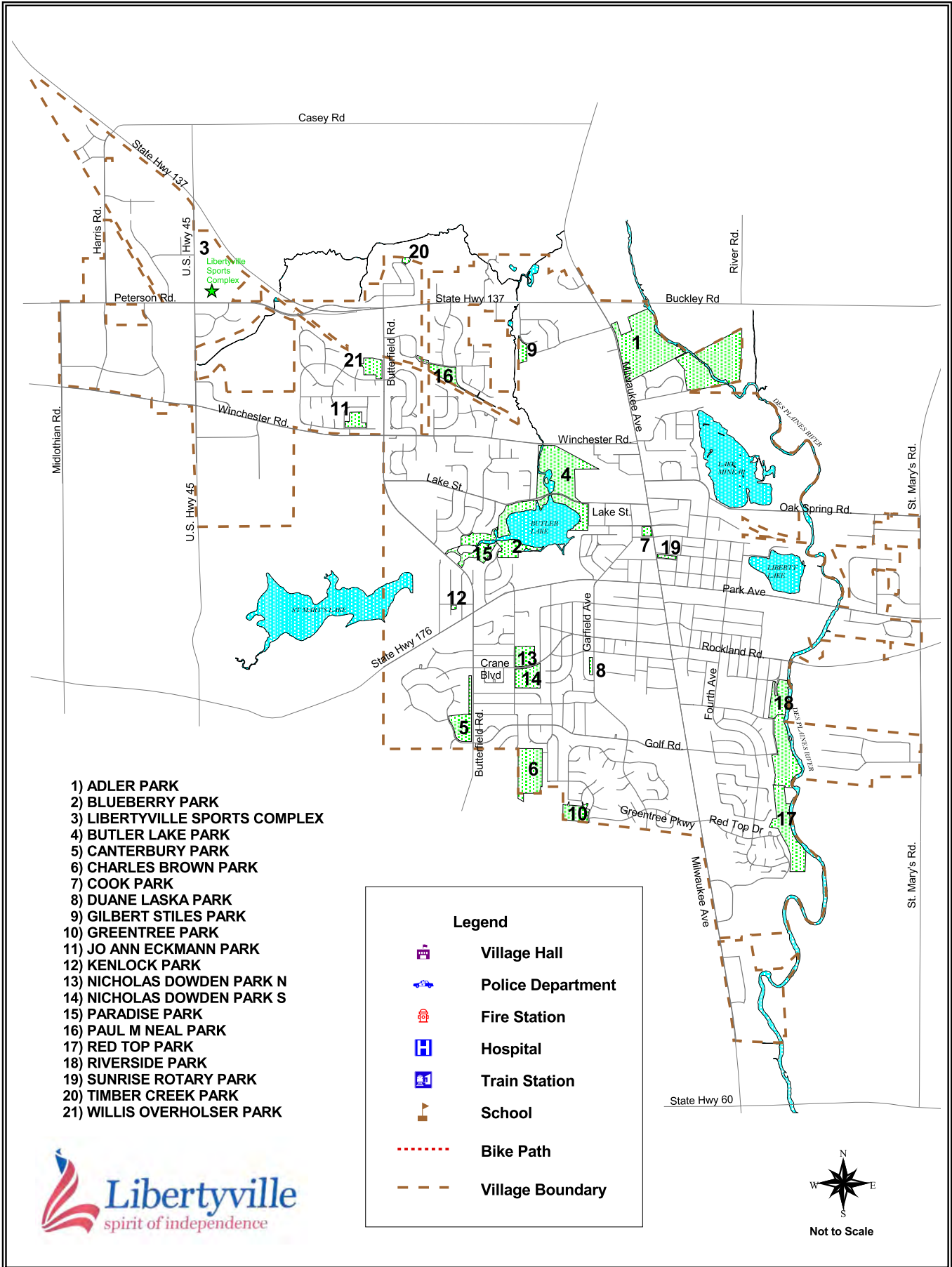
Non-Residents: \$20
